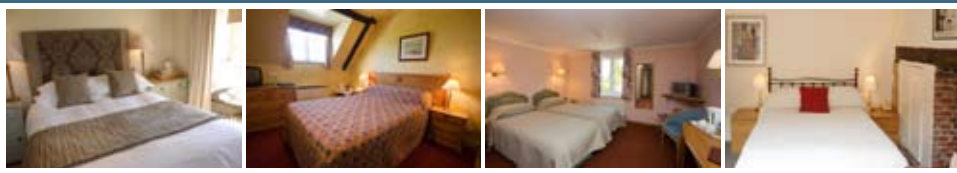

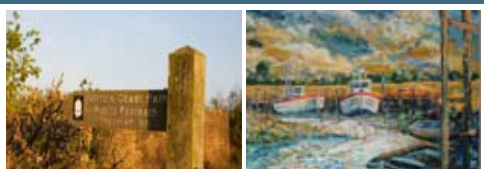

A country pub with Mediterranean style, offering accommodation, good ales & a pizza & pie based menu served in the bars & patio areas. family friendly.

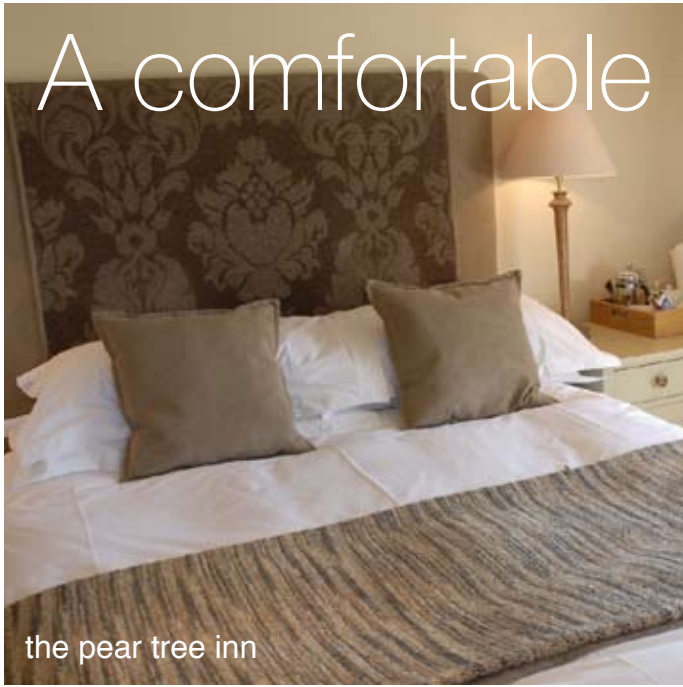


The Angel Hotel

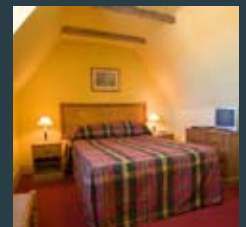

The south facing conservatory at The Lifeboat Inn, one of the many areas to be seated to enjoy our bar food.



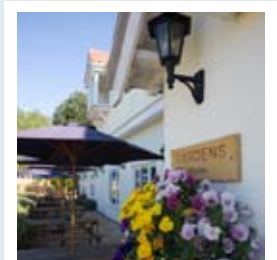
The Old Coach House main restaurant area serving a pizza, pasta & pie menu, the bar areas and sunny patio areas have table seating too.
